### School Meal Service Distribution Announcement

REVISED: March 15, 2020

The Student Nutrition Department will be providing meals for all children within the Espanola Public Schools (EPS) service area.

- Meal services are available for all children, ages 1-18 for grab-and-go service within the community.
- All children are eligible, including EPS, private school, charter school and other public-school children within the Espanola Public Schools Service area.
- ***Children must be present*** to receive and be counted for meal delivery.

#### **Meal Sites Locations: March 16-18**

- All EPS school locations will serve to-go meals at sites.
- Breakfast will be served from 7:45 AM to 8:30 PM and lunch from 11:45am to 12:30pm.
- Please follow school staff directions for meal pick up logistics.

#### **Meal Site Locations: March 19- April 3 (ongoing)**

- Espanola Valley High School, Dixon Elementary and Abiquiu Elementary will continue to offer grab-and-go meals at their school sites. Breakfast will be served from 7:45 AM to 8:30 PM and lunch from 11:45am to 12:30pm.
- Students and families should not get down from their vehicles.
- Parents and families will pull up to bus loops, students will be counted and grab-and-go meals provided for students who are present.

#### **Community Meal Delivery Routes: March 19-April 3**

- Starting Thursday, March 18 with the assistance of the Transportation Department we will be delivering grab-and-go meals at designated locations within our district.
- We are asking that parents and families arrive 10-15 minutes before the designated delivery time
- Meal stop times are approximate, we may need to revise the delivery schedule and stops as we continue. Please check our website frequently for updated times and routes.
- Parents or a responsible adult are encouraged to accompany students to delivery stops in order to assist with safety and supervision; however, this is not a requirement. Students must be present to receive a meal.
- Safety will be of utmost importance as we implement this system. We ask for your support in this effort.
